When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went out to meet him, but Mary stayed at home. John 11:20

3) DEAD IN THE _____.

On his arrival, Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days... 21 “Lord,” Martha said to Jesus, “if you had been here, my brother would not have died.” John 11:17, 21
